AT-RISK YOUTH BENEFIT FROM 15TH ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT **IN SUPPORT OF NEW VOCATIONAL PROGRAM**

MT. HOLLY, New Jersey, April, 2007— The Children's Home Golf Tournament was held at Deerwood Country Club in Mount Holly, NJ on April 23, 2007. Proceeds from the event benefit The Children's Home new Vocational Cosmetology Program. This program's inception provides the first opportunity for much needed and desired vocational training on The Children's Home, Mount Holly campus. Class instruction begins in September, and students will acquire knowledge and practical skills in the Cosmetology Arts and small business operation and ownership. These valuable marketable skills will help bring New Jersey at-risk youth one step closer to becoming self sufficient, productive members of society. An unfortunate fact of disadvantaged, at-risk youth is that they are less likely to pursue higher education or other skill training than their peers. Instead of returning to a life of crime and impoverishment, vocational programs enhance academic achievement and a motivation for learning leading to career development and increased employability.

Dobbins School offers an academic program within a highly therapeutic environment for children experiencing learning disabilities, behavioral problems, and emotional disturbances. Mercer House Shelter is a short term, residential facility serving homeless and adjudicated youth from Mercer County (Mercer House is owned by Mercer County and operated by the Children's Home). ###
