Program Overview



Fastow Supported Housing consists of two fully furnished, 2 bedroom apartments located in a two-story brick building in Mount Holly, New Jersey. Each apartment is complete with a kitchen, dining room, living room, and a sun porch. Laundry machines are located in the basement of the building.

Male and female tenants are accepted, however co-habitation within the apartments is prohibited.

Residents must be employed full-time or part-time, and provide their own transportation to and from work.

Residents are responsible for paying rent equivalent to 30% of their monthly net income.

Vehicles are permitted and must be legally registered, insured, and inspected. A private parking lot and garage are located on the premises.

The assigned Case Manager regularly meets with each youth to support, encourage, and provide training and instruction.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be between the ages of 18 & 21.
- Must be able to read and write on at least a 6th grade level and have graduated from high school or passed the GED test.
- Must be willing to enroll in an education program (college, trade school, etc.).

Our Goal:

To assist and train aging-out youth with developing the knowledge and skills they need to be self-sufficient and independent.
